

# Supernova F1

**Maturity:**

Early maturing, approximately 10 days earlier than Nova.

**Plant type:**

Fast growing hybrid Nantes/Kuroda with strong tops with solid attachment which facilitates machine harvest.

**Roots:**

Exceptional quality roots which are ultra-smooth and with the strongest orange colour both externally and internally currently in the market. Length 17-20cm, crown diameter is 4cm.

**Comments:**

An adaptable variety. Needs to be sown at > 750 000/Ha otherwise the crown diameter will increase above 4cm.

**Harvest season:**

Tolerant to bolting under average climatic conditions and best suited to early autumn through winter and spring harvest in all areas.

IR: Ad

**Disease key:**

Ad - Alternaria leaf blight (*Alternaria dauci*)

**Pack size:**

1 million seeds
