

Star Gem F1



Plant:

Compact vigorous plant with short internodes, resulting in short runners and high concentrated yield.

Pack size:

1,000 & 55,000 seeds

Fruit:

Round, dark green fruit suitable for picking as a baby gem or for mature fruit. Mature fruit maintain the dark green colour longer than open pollinated varieties.

Maturity:

Fruit mature in 70 - 80 days, which is 10 days earlier than open pollinated varieties.

General:

Compact plant style allows for higher plant density with 20000 plants per hectare in the heat and 15 - 18000 plants per hectare in the cool.
