Plant:

Indeterminate plant for greenhouse production, grafting is recommended on one head

Fruit:

Yellow ribbed heirloom type with green shoulder and strong ribbing, 190-250g in size, and with sweet flavour. Cluster pruning to 2/3 fruit is recommended

Characteristics:

This yellow heirloom is recommended for greenhouse production with extended harvesting life through grafting. The fruit provide interesting presentation and high taste and sugars.

Disease resistance:

HR: ToMV 0-2, Va, Vd, Fol1, Pf1-5

Disease key:

ToMV - Tomato Mosaic Virus
Va - Verticillium wilt (Verticillium albo-atrum)
Vd - Verticillium wilt (Verticillium dahliae)
Fol1-2 - Fusarium wilt race 1 (Fusarium oxysporum f.sp.lycopersici)
Ff - Leaf mould (Fulvia fulva)
